### **Practice Gap/Need and Course Description:**

The psychanalytic process is poorly defined as currently understood. The way dreams introduced in session draw the analytic dyad into enactments, regardless of the analyst's theoretic orientation is underappreciated. That dreams become the focus of enactments regardless of the analyst's theoretical orientation has not been recognized.
